- ✳ Applications must be received by 5pm, Friday 29 March 2019.
- ✳ Applicants must be registered in a current training agreement with the BCITO in one of the following trades: architectural aluminium joinery, brick and block laying, carpentry, concrete, exterior plastering, flooring, frame & truss, glass & glazing, interior systems, joinery, masonry/stonemasonry, painting & decorating, tiling.
- ✳ Applicants must be at least 18 years of age at the time of application (Outward Bound requirement).
- ✳ Accepted participants must complete a medical clearance through a GP as part of the Outward Bound enrolment process.
- ✳ Accepted participants must have a minimum fitness – to run 3.2km in under 25 minutes and be able to complete a full day of activities.*
- ✳ Applicants must have employer confirmation that paid leave (over and above the applicant's annual entitlement) will be granted for the duration of the programme (8 - 23 June 2019 = 10 working days leave required).
- ✳ Short-listed applicants may be required to be part of a pre-selection telephone interview.
- ✳ The awarded Outward Bound course is not transferable (to another person) and the offer is valid only for the Outward Bound construction watch during June 2019.
- ✳ By submitting an application, the applicant has accepted the terms and conditions of the Outward Bound programme.
- ✳ The applicant agrees that the selection panel may contact your local BCITO representative, the workplace assessor and your employer to confirm details of your application.
- ✳ Both the participant and the employer agree to provide post-course feedback to BCITO.
