

Most Promising Apprenticeship Judging Criteria

What do the judges look for in your application:

- Experience - is the applicant skill set where it should be?
- Relationship with employer and colleagues
- Point of difference. What makes the applicant stand out amongst others?
- Engagement on myBCITO
- Preparation before each site visit with Training Advisor

Apprentice of the Year Judging Criteria

What do the judges look for in your application:

- Leadership skills
- Skill set of the applicant.
- Relationship with employer and colleagues
- Knowledge on product (Broad knowledge on glass/windows as applicable)
- Point of difference. What makes the applicant stand out amongst others?
- Is the applicant training people or running their own jobs?
- Participation, behaviour, contribution and dedication to training (includes block course for G&G apprentices)
- Engagement on myBCITO
- Preparation before each site visit with Training Advisor

PLEASE NOTE:

For all award nominations, judges will contact the applicant's employer and their BCITO Training Advisor to get a better understanding of the apprentice at work and their preparation for their site visit and engagement on myBCITO.

The Allan Sage Memorial Award is awarded for apprentice excellence and may be awarded to the Glass & Glazing Apprentice of the Year. This is at the discretion to the judges.
